**PINELLAS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TAKES H1N1 VACCINES
TO CHILD-CARE CENTERS IN JANUARY**

Child-care centers are the next locations for the Pinellas County Health Department's H1N1 vaccination outreach efforts in January. On Thursday, Jan. 7, three child-care centers in north, mid and south Pinellas will provide free H1N1 vaccines from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. to children and their parents. Since children younger than 9 require two H1N1 doses, the Pinellas County Health Department will return to the same locations for the second vaccine on Feb. 4.
